

There is currently a memorial headstone in Lullaby Land, located in Elmwood Cemetery, where children lost to miscarriage under 20 weeks are laid to rest. Our goal is to build a prayer pathway using pavers in Lullaby Land which will lead up to the current memorial headstone. Parents who lose a child to miscarriage will have the option of having their child's name and date of loss engraved on a paver to help with the grieving process.


