

This report is intended to provide community partners with a COVID-19 status update, and brief you on activities the health department is working on to respond. We have also included links for guidance recently released, we thought might be useful to you. This report will be sent out once a week to keep everyone updated as we continue to work our way through the COVID pandemic.

County Response Actions:

- CG Public Health continues to provide COVID-19 vaccines at the department on Wednesday's
 & Friday's. We had 44 people register for a vaccine on Wednesday and 47 on Friday.
- We provided second dose shots at Newman this week, to follow up to the first dose clinic that was offered.
- We continue to work with MercyOne to investigate opportunities to provide booster dose
- Our PIO has been working on a media campaign to encourage vaccine uptake prior to the start of the school year.
- The PIO is also working on creating a message to outline who is eligible for the 3rd vaccination (defining who fits in the immunocompromised group), and when the general public may be eligible. We are also developing scripting for staff to use to screen those who call in to determine eligibility.
- Tracking incoming calls to watch for an increase in call volume that might trigger the opening
 of the call center. IT has set up our phone system so it is ready to go, should we reach the
 point of needing to activate it.
