This event complements the *Vision North Iowa* strategic planning efforts.

HOUSING DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION PARTNERS TO MOVE 3 MASON CITY HOMES

Over the past year the Corridor has continued to place a significant focus on meeting the ongoing housing needs of North Iowa. To help drive this effort, the North Iowa Corridor Housing Development Corporation was created as a 501c3 non-profit to take the lead and carry out the action plan developed through the Mason City Housing Initiative created last year. The HDC aims to address the housing needs of the community by creating and preserving quality, affordable housing units.

The HDC will be able to apply for grant opportunities addressing housing needs, and partner with local government entities and businesses to create workforce housing opportunities. "Our communities have had a significant need for housing, and it has often impacted our business's ability to attract talent," Schreck said. "This isn't unique to North Iowa, as it is estimated by the Iowa Economic Development Authority that the state needs at least 23,000 new housing units to meet demand by 2030."

The first project currently underway for the HDC, in partnership with the City of Mason City, and local developer RCP Investments, is to move three houses from their current locations at the former Blackmore Nursery site across from MercyOne. RCP Investments purchased the properties and will clear the former Blackmore site and houses to create a 1-acre site for commercial projects. Rather than demolish the 3 houses, they are donating them to the HDC, who will move them to 3 vacant lots owned by the city of Mason City.

The houses are each about 900 square feet and have garages that have already been moved. The HDC is putting new basements and foundations in at the new sites and will renovate and update the houses to prepare them for sale by next spring. The goal is to provide them to eligible buyers at affordable prices. This project is being funded by a grant by the City of Mason City, and all proceeds from the sales will be reinvested into future housing projects.

Chad Schreck, the CEO of the North Iowa Corridor Economic Development Corporation, said "The project is a good opportunity to save these houses and provide more options for the workforce. The goal of the HDC is to complement the efforts of private developers by taking on projects that would not be profitable or feasible for them but can fill an important need for our community."

The HDC was established in 2022 by the EDC, which is a public-private partnership that promotes economic growth and development in the region. The HDC is a partnership between the City of Mason City, City of Clear Lake, and Cerro Gordo County, and will focus its efforts in the communities to improve blighted properties and create new housing opportunities.

The house moving project is expected to be completed by the spring of 2024, and the homes will begin to be marketed then, though interested parties may reach out to Chad Schreck at cschreck@northiowacorridor. com. The HDC will continue to evaluate future projects to create single-family and multi-family homes, and also can work with businesses interested exploring potential partnerships to create quality, attainable workforce housing.

North Iowa Navigators




he Chamber is looking to expand its **Community Concierge** program by utilizing community members to help in make North Iowa a more welcoming place.


Operation Thank You


