

# **85th North Iowa Band Festival**

G et ready! It's time to rock and roll into the **85th North Iowa Band Festival**! The **Band Festival** committee has been hard at work planning yet another fun-filled Memorial Day weekend that is sure to knock your leg warmers off! That's right! The theme for this year's festival is "80s Rewind." You can expect lots of bright colors, big hairdos, and classic 80s hits played by a lineup of North Iowa bands. This beloved tradition will take place from May 23-27 in Downtown Mason City.

# **Festival Entertainment**



In the spirit of celebrating local musicians, the John Adams Middle School Band will kick off the weekend on Thursday night, followed by a performance from the Mason City Municipal Band. Not only that, but for the first time there will be

a Totally Tubular Downtown Crawl that will feature 80s-themed activities and drink specials. **Band Festival** Buttons will unlock access to exclusive discounts at participating locations! Thursday will also be the opening night of the carnival that will feature exciting rides, fun games, and delicious fair foods!

On Friday, the talented Mason City High School Orchestra is scheduled at 5PM at the Principal Performing Arts Pavilion. The Mason City High School Jazz Band will play at 6PM on the Main Stage, followed by a performance by Not Quite Brothers at 7:30PM.

Saturday's entertainment begins with The 34th Annual Stu Nevermann Run at 8AM, followed by the BIG parade at 10AM that runs down East State Street from North Penn to the High School. Then, the state champion MCHS Danzers will perform at 1PM at the Principal Pavilion before the Awards Ceremony at 1:30PM. The instrument petting zoo will be held from 2-4PM. At 2PM, local musician Paul Weitzel will be performing on the Main Stage, the first of many local bands to hit the stage at this year's **North Iowa Band Festival**! Shortly after, the Bill Riley Talent Show will commence at the Principal Pavilion at 2:30PM. This show will serve as the area's first competition of the summer, and the winner will advance to the Iowa State Fair in August.







Going into Saturday afternoon/evening, the Main Stage performances will continue with Levi Smith at 3:15PM, Juni West at 4:30PM, The Mercury 3 at 6PM, the Mockingbirds at 7:30PM, and Betty and the Gents closing out the night at 9PM. Meanwhile, the carnival, concessions, and marketplace will be open to the public.



For those wishing for one last ride or one more fair snack, the carnival will continue Sunday and Monday, both opening at 12PM. The marketplace will also be open for its final day on Sunday at 11AM. Also on Sunday, Trinity Lutheran Church will be hosting their Annual Outdoor Worship Service beginning at 9AM.

North Iowa. Their efforts were recognized in 2023 when they were inducted into the Iowa Rock 'n Roll Hall of Fame. They are also the 2016 recipients of the Klempnauer Award.

Every year, the **Band Festival** team counts on Dennis and Don to set up the Globe Gazette Muse-Norris Charitable Fund Stage for the headline performers, and they often run the sound system for various bands. Dennis served for many years on the **North Iowa Band Festival** Committee and remembers well the intense planning that went on the year the **Band Festival** (briefly) switched to the fall.

Dennis and Don grew up in Mason City, and remember attending the **North Iowa Band Festival** each year as children. They can recall exactly where they watched each year, but never imagined they would one day lead the parade as honorees.

Even after decades of hard work behind the scenes, Dennis and Don say they enjoy the festival immensely. Dennis said he participates year after year because he enjoys the "connection with other people, being part of the project from the start... and seeing it through to completion." Don was surprised to receive the honor, remarking "we work on this all the time, but never expected to have this recognition."

# Klempnaur - Lindsey James

The Klempnauer Award was named for Dan Klempnauer, a long-time volunteer and festival supporter, and is intended to honor an unsung hero who volunteers for the festival. This year's honoree is Lindsey James, Executive Director of Visit Mason City and Main Street Mason City.

# Band Master - Alan Greiner

The Band Master Award originated in 1990 to honor a retiring band master in recognition of outstanding work in the field of music with area youth. This year, the **North Iowa Band Festival** will honor Alan Greiner who recently completed a successful 21 year career teaching instrumental music.

During his tenure with the Iowa High School Music Association (IHSMA), Greiner was instrumental

in crafting and promoting the image and philosophy of the association, and he cared deeply about ensuring youth music directors have every tool they need to be successful. He has also been an influential figure on the national scene as a collaborator with the National Federation of Hic

He has also been an influential figure on the national scene as a collaborator with the National Federation of High School Associations. Greiner and other NFHS leadership worked in conjunction with music publishers to help teachers and activity sponsors understand and apply copyright law as it relates to education. He also assisted in the development of a music adjudication training course for NFHS and chaired the NFHS Music Committee for four years.

"When I think of the influence that Alan has had on music education in the state of Iowa, I don't even know where to start in singing his praises," said Kurt Schwarck, president of the IHSMA Executive Committee. "Alan's leadership has created tremendous opportunities for music education across the state. His focus on the value of music education in our schools and creating opportunities for Iowa high school students to grow and become well-rounded individuals is second to none."




